INFORMATION REGARDING TRAVELING TO MOZAMBIQUE

The President of the Republic of Mozambique Felipe Jacinto Nyusi announced on October 29th, in his address to the Nation, the following:

- ✓ All visitors will not be required to quarantine on arrival if they present a negative PCR test (not older than 72 hours);
- ✓ The PCR test is valid for 14 days from the date of collection, to allow multi entry in the Country or short trip abroad;
- ✓ Children up to the age of 11 are exempt from the test requirement to enter Mozambique;
- ✓ Resume Tourist Visas;

General Information:

For International and SADC travellers who are self-driving between South Africa and Mozambique:

- A negative PCR test result is required for crossing from South Africa to Mozambique at Lebombo/Ressano Garcia Border Post and it should not be older than 72 hours from the time the test is taken.
- The negative PCR test result is valid for 14 days for multiply entries within South Africa and Mozambique (within a 14 day period).
- Visa Processing are allowed in reciprocal basis.

- International passengers are allowed to travel to Mozambique, including for tourism and leisure in reciprocal basis.
- Passengers have to present proof of Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test with a negative result for SARS-CoV-2 on arrival, carried out in the country of origin in the last 72 hours before departure.
